Securing the future of Brooklands Technical College

- After several years in the making, planning permission was approved by Elmbridge Borough Council in December 2023 for the redevelopment of the College's Weybridge campus.
- The approval secured a Further Education College offering skills based training across Surrey, including a new specialist SEND building with increased capacity for growing demand with additional funding from Surrey County Council).
- The partnership with Cala Homes enabled the College to repay the ESFA, as well as invest and upgrade the College facilities and teaching spaces.
- CALA Homes are building the Sports Hall and Community Space at no cost to the College.

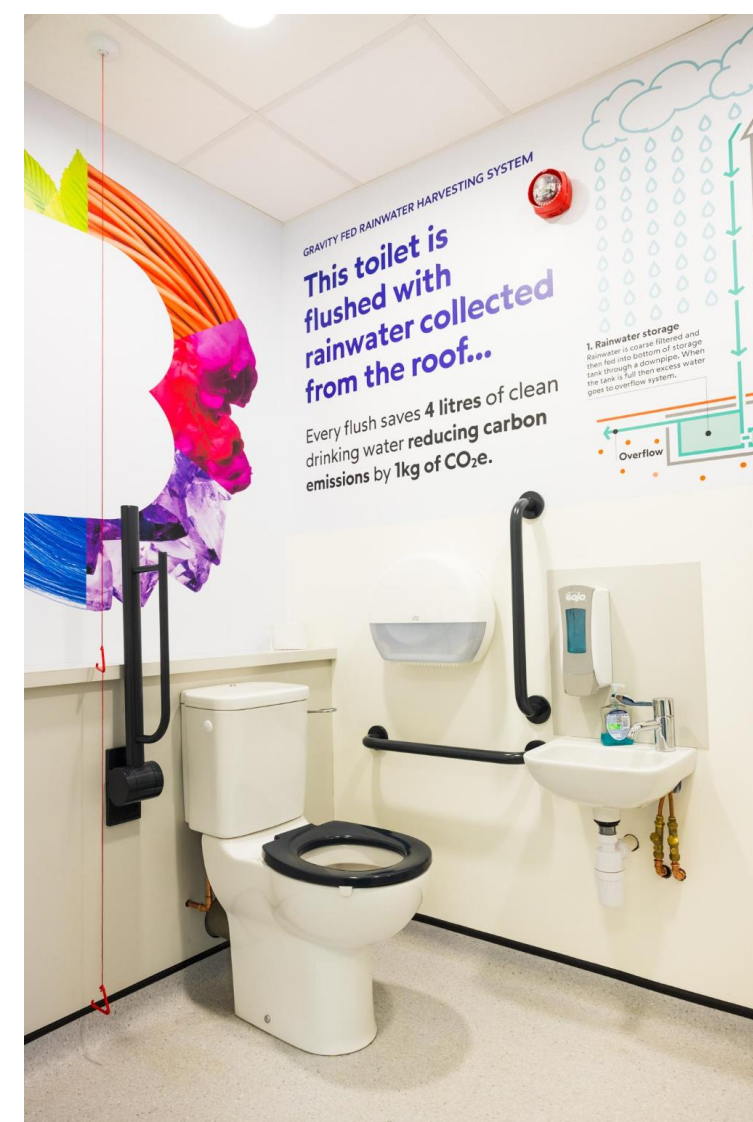

Phase One- Estates Development Update

What's been achieved to date?

- Rebrand project to align Brooklands Technical College with the community that it serves
- New branding at the entrance to the site and around campus
- Completion of the Low Carbon Centre (LSIF Funding)
- Redevelopment work has started on 3 main areas: The Edge, Barnes Wallis and Tower
- New car park area for staff and students
- New facilities at the Ashford campus - Building Services





Phase One – Estates Development Update

Brooks Restaurant and Brooks Hair & Beauty – Barnes Wallis Building

This area will be reconfigured internally to create subject spaces for Hair and Beauty, Travel and Tourism, Catering, Brooks Restaurant and Brooks Hair & Beauty Salon and student dining/breakout area.

This is where the College will integrate with the community. Members of the public will be able to benefit from the services offered by the College and a safeguarding line within the building will ensure that members of the public are unable to access the inner college.

Completion: Summer 2025













Phase One – Estates Development Update

Health and Care Courses - Edge Building

The new home for the College's health and social care and science provision with cutting edge laboratory space, simulated nursery and a model hospital ward to deliver the new government T level qualifications.

Completion: February 2025

Dedicated Teaching Space - Tower Building

The Tower building will provide classroom space, that will be utilised by the College for the teaching of theory, workshops, tutorial activity and English and maths. The top floor will be a dedicated 14-16 year old classroom space. All areas will have improved access to the use of technology which as an impact, will enhance teaching and learning.

April 2026

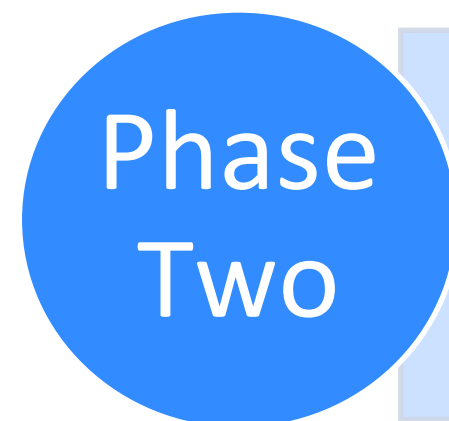
Sports Hall/Community Hub complete
